## **WHITE WINES**

## **Per Bottle**

### **Birtley House White - Bergerie de la Bastide Blanc 2009, France**

£8

This interesting blend of Grenache Blanc, Sauvignon and Ugni Blanc, reveals typical notes of dried herbs, white flowers, green olive with a touch of citrus at the finish.

### **Chardonnay Viu Manent 2009, Chile**

£10

Displays lifted tropical notes, backed up by subtle biscuit-like oak, in the mouth. Full bodied and zingy.

### **Gaillac Blanc Clement Termes 2009, France**

£10

Unusual blend of Mauzac, Loinde l'Oeil Muscadelle and Sauvignon exhibits fragrant apple blossom aromas and vibrant fruit. A floral and fruity delight.

### **Sauvignon Touraine 2009, France**

£11

Shows lifted aromas of elderflower cordial, Victoria plums and hints of grass. The palate is filled with clean gooseberry and elderflower fruit.

### **Gavi La Fornace 2009, Italy**

£12

This wine is really fresh and floral, with a clean and pleasant finish of toasted almonds. A lovely refreshing wine made from the Cortese grape.

### **Bergerac Chateau Tour De Gendre 2009, France**

£13

A creamy Semillon dominated effort, spending eight months on the lees and a month in barrique for the Muscadelle thus showing good weight in the mouth.

### **Riesling Framingham Estate 2008, New Zealand**

£14

This wine is all about minerality, a complex nose leads to flavours of orange, citrus and mandarin, lemon, honey and stonefruit with a grippy mineral finish.

### **Sancerre La Vigne Blanche 2009, France**

£16

Initially steely, this ripens in the mouth and unfurls an array of flavours- peach, grapefruit, asparagus, lime zest and honey.

### **Chablis Premier Cru Gerard Tremblay 2009, France**

£19

These forty-year-old vines from the Montmaine vineyard reflect a fine wine with a profound mineral nose, great weight in the mouth and a long sumptuous finish.

## **ROSE WINES**

**Per Bottle**

### **Bergerie de la Bastide Rose 2009, Spain**

£8

An elegant nose of wild red berries is complemented by notes of Mediterranean flowers. Round and soft on the palate this wine has a perfect balance between rich aromas of fruits and a fresh acidity.

### **Alquezar Rosado 2009, Spain**

£9

With a lovely grenadine colour, this blend of Tempranillo-Garnacha is full bodied and is made for easy drinking despite its 13.5% abv.

## **RED WINES**

**Per bottle**

### **Birtley House Red - Bergerie de la Bastide Rouge 2009, France**

£8

Grenache Noir, Cinsault, Merlot, this wine is built on the twin pillars of fruit and structure. It is light, clean and fresh on the palate.

### **Merlot Casa Azul 2010, Chile**

£9

Plum with a little pepper on the nose. In the mouth it offers ripe fruit, smooth with soft rounded tannins and a silky finish with hints of mocha.

### **Cabernet-Sauvignon Domaine Henri Nordoc 2008, France**

£9

This Vin de Pays D'Oc shows a touch of clove-edged bitterness and Languedoc herbs that marks its individuality.

### **Rioja Albergada 2009, Spain**

£10

Sound Rioja which has an incredibly sweet mid-palate of black fruits intermixed with subtle spice, concentrated yet soft and elegant on the finish.

### **Montepulciano d'Abruzzo 2009, Italy**

£10

This bold Montepulciano has a great plum-skin fruit allied to a leathery warmth with an all over chocolate finish.

### **Merlot Domaine Mouline 2007, France**

£11

This Merlot is beautifully balanced with a nose of red cherries, which opens to a soft mouth of black fruits, fresh plums, blackberries and easy tannins.

### **Gaillac Cuvee des Drille 2009, France**

£11

With 75% Duras and 25% Fer this wine has bright peppery notes, hints of Seville orange, bitter cherry and an appealing suppleness in the mouth.

### **Pinot Noir Boussole 2009, France**

£12

This displays ripe strawberry fruit flavours, very easy drinking and can be served lightly chilled.

<b>Cote du Rhone Chapoton 2009, France</b>	£13
Mainly Syrah with Grenache and a little Mourvedre, aromas of violets and soft black fruits dominate and silky ripe tannins lubricate the transition in the mouth.	
<b>Cabernet Sauvignon Salentein 2007, Argentina</b>	£15
Aged for twelve months in French oak, the wine has aromas of pepper, red berry jam, dried mushrooms, coconut and vanilla. Intense ruby colour with a long finish.	
<b>Rioja Hacienda Reserva 2005, Spain</b>	£18.50
Aged in American and French oak the Reserva is structured, with dense plummy fruit and a good tannic structure.	
<b>Chateau Annereaux Lalande de Pomerol 2004, France</b>	£19
Nuances of spice, leather and chocolate combine with lush fruit and silky tannins to provide depth and layers of flavour in the wine.	

## **CHAMPAGNE & SPARKING WINES**

<b>Birtley House Champagne - Jean Paul Deville Carte Noire N/V</b>	£19
Reserve wine is added to this lush Champagne that has a high proportion of Pinot Noir in the blend and is fairly full in style. Representing excellent value for money this champagne holds its ground among the more well known Champagne houses.	
<b>Laurent Perrier Brut N/V</b>	£31
<b>Prosecco Cantina Bernardi N/V</b>	£11
The nose suggests blanched almonds, white flowers and pearskin, the palate is soft and clean with apple and quince fruit flavours with a naturally off-dry finish.
